General Guidelines for the Integrated Holiday Homework Project (2016-17)

1. Punched ruled sheets to be used. At least 6 to 8 A-4 size sheets should be there excluding the cover page and content page. Page one of the project should give introduction.
2. Detailed Index of Content and Picture Gallery with serial number should be given.
3. The project must be hand written. However, some pictures may be pasted.
4. Cover page should be made aesthetically.
 - Should be creative indicating the name of the student along with the class & section and session (2016-17).
5. All pictures downloaded from the internet, must indicate the address of the website.
 - Make a time line of events
 - You may make a collage of photographs to demonstrate a particular point.
 - Use newspaper clippings
6. Bibliography- indicating address of the website, books, journals etc. referred to.
7. Last page has to be a Certificate Page certifying that the entire work has been done by the child himself /herself.

INTEGRATED HOLIDAY HOME WORK (2016-17)

Class - VII

Theme: 'My Delhi, as I See It'

- I. Design a poster expressing how you see the capital. The poster can highlight the positive side, the negative side or a mixed perspective. You may design the poster on any of the following themes: a) People of Delhi b) Food of Delhi c) Delhi's Infrastructure d) Citizen Security/ Welfare in Delhi. e) Law and Order in Delhi

Try to include the recent developments, as highlighted in the news, related to the theme of your choice. The poster should be colourful and attractive.

Accompanying the poster should be a write-up of 150 words explaining your vision in the poster.

(Read the supplementary reader *The Road to the Bazaar* to be tested as a part of Cycle Test -2.)

- II. Visit a science gallery in Delhi.

Make a brochure / pamphlet mentioning the principle and working of any 5 exhibits. Also paste the pictures for the same.

- III. a) Collect the data for number of cars per family for 30 families in your city. Make frequency distribution table and draw bar graph.

b) Write the number of each car and find the fractions of odd number of cars and even number of cars. Convert each fraction in decimal and percentage.

- IV. Prepare a travel brochure on Delhi focusing on its following aspects:

- History
- Culture
- Geography
- Social Life
- Political Life
- Development

Note:

- The brochure should be made on an A-4 size sheet.
- Use of actual pictures, photographs, maps and data will be appreciated.
- Information should be handwritten.
