- ★ Do 10 minutes of Yoga / Meditation daily.
- ★ Help your mother to lay the table or welcome the guests / greet them well and show them respect.

English

- ★ Encourage your ward to speak small sentences in English and help them to use it atleast 2 sentences per day which will help them to communicate and express effectively in English.
- ★ Use of golden words like Thank You / Sorry / Excuse Me / Please / Welcome should be encouraged.
- ★ Make the concept of Today / Tomorrow & Yesterday clear to your ward.
- ★ Read simple story books to your ward during bed time to inculcate good reading habit for example.
 - Bubble Bruno Series
 - Mind Fuels etc.
- ★ For enhancing speaking skills hold conversation with your ward on topics.
 - Child answering on the phone
 - Child with a guest
 - Child with a friend
- ★ Practice reading and writing of 2 letter word i.e. in / it / on / at / am etc. (regularly)
- ★ a - z in sequence to be done in 3 in 1 copy (10 times) [Only the letters done so far]
- ★ Reading 2 and 3 letters words should be done regularly with phonetic sounds.
- ★ Dictation of letters (twice a week) from a to z.

Maths:

Oral counting should be memorized daily (1-50).

Following concepts should be practiced 3 times each. (in 3 in 1 copy)

- ★ Written counting 1 -20
- ★ What come after 1 – 10 (2times in a week)
- ★ Random counting (from 1 to 50)
- ★ Dictation of numbers upto 40
- ★ Back counting (20 – 1)

Make a collage out of waste material on A-3 sheet.

Following material can be used:

- ★ Bottle caps
 - ★ Toffee wrappers
 - ★ Dry flowers and leaves
 - ★ Dry fruit seeds
 - ★ Pistachio shells etc.
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- ★ Now, count the number of each material used and write the numbers below on the collage.
 - ★ Paste the number cards of numbers 1 - 10 on the floor and use the same to help children learn the concept of before and after by jumping on numbers.

EVS:

1. Take your ward for a nature walk in the garden
 - a. Make him aware of the surrounding by discussing about various types of leaves, flowers, plants, insects and birds.
 - b. Also talk about the related activities involved in it like digging, sowing of seeds, watering the plants etc. and ask him to do so.
 - c. Encourage him to be a part of cleanliness drive by picking up the waste material (wrappers etc.) from the grass and throwing them in the dustbin.
 - d. Click some photographs of your ward there, (involved in these activities) and paste them in a collage on A-3 pastel sheet.
2. Keep some grains and water in small bowls in the balcony / open areas of your home to feed, the birds. Observe the birds carefully - watch their beak, feather and claws etc. when they come.
3. Hot weather is the breeding time of mosquitoes which leads to various diseases. Children should be made aware of its causes and ill effects. Take a visit to nearby pond, drains to observe the breeding of mosquitoes in the stagnant water. Tell them about the preventive methods.
